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2. SCHEDULE (April 22nd - April 28th, 2024)

Monday 22/4/2024

Welcoming of the guests by the Greek families and the Greek teachers at the airport
- Teachers settle in their apartment and students in the families

Tuesday 23/4/2024

Ice breaking activities – Start of work – Tour of well-known monuments of the city
8.15 - 12.30 at school, 12.30 - 15.00 in the city

8.30- 8.45: Welcoming of guests - presentation of school and city

8.45- 9.30: Ice breaking activities – Playing with terms from the glossary

9.30- 10.00: Breakfast (offered by the host school)

10.00 – 11.00: Activities related to the topic "Sustainable tourism and monuments" (in two groups alternately) a) In the Gym (5 groups x 4 = 20): Declaring the principles of sustainable management of monuments (Do's and Don'ts) b) In the IT classroom (3 groups x 6 = 18): Creation of a digital map with 4 well-known and 4 less well-known monuments of each city (Barcelona, Dresden, Thessaloniki)

12.00 – 12.30: Light meal at school

Description	Students will work in groups on the topic of "Sustainable tourism and monuments".
