Activity 2: Cultural visits	
Description	Students will visit different tourist attractions during their stay in Latvia.
Learning outcomes	<p>Students will learn about local history and culture, and empower their European sense of belonging from a common past.</p> <p>Students will learn how to appreciate Latvian architectural and artistic works, as well as their habits and traditions.</p> <p><i>Key competences:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Cultural awareness and expression competence.

Activity 3: Project work at the institution	
Description	Students have to work in groups and do some research on the project about eco-tourism.
Learning outcomes	<p>Students will design an eco-tourism tour in Latvia.</p> <p><i>Key competences:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Mathematical competence and competence in science, technology and engineering- Multilingual competence- Entrepreneurship competence



Activity 4: Hiking in Natural Areas	
Description	Students will be hiking in "The Great Kemeri Bog" and learn about tourism and its effects on nature.
Learning outcomes	Students will be more environmentally aware as participants, as locals, as visitors-tourists or as future professionals-employees regarding the topic of sustainable tourism in natural areas. <i>Key competences:</i> - Citizenship competence
