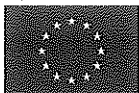

It is designed for students in lower secondary education (our students were born in 2010).</p> <p>The project has these two main goals:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To do scientific research about topics related to the local environment. • To improve English language skills, being the language of communication for this project. <p>Each investigation follows the scientific method. We start by introducing the topic and getting some background information. Then, we ask some questions about the topic and state our hypotheses. We design our investigation to verify our hypothesis and we start the process of data collection. Once we gather all the data, we analyze the results.</p>

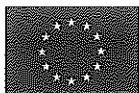

Activity 1: Participating in classes

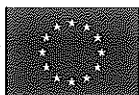

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Activity 3: Local guides	
Description	Polish students will guide Spanish students during shared visits and activities in their own country.
Learning outcomes	Polish students will learn how to act as ambassadors of their own country. <i>Key competences:</i> - <i>Citizenship competence</i> - <i>Cultural awareness and expression competence</i>

Activity 4: Cultural visits	
Description	Students will visit different tourist attractions during the stay in Italy.
Learning outcomes	Students will learn about local history and culture, and empower their European sense of belonging from a common past. Students will learn how to appreciate their architectural and artistic works, as well as, Polish habits and traditions. <i>Key competences:</i> - <i>Cultural awareness and expression competence.</i>

Activity 5: Data analysis	
Description	Students, from both countries, will investigate and use the scientific method. During the stay, both countries will sit together and they will analyse their results in small groups. They will prepare a slide presentation with the data analysis. They will compare the data that they collect during the visit in Granollers and the data collected now in Bordighera.
Learning outcomes	Students will analyse the results of their scientific research. <i>Key competences:</i> <i>Mathematical competence and competence in science, technology and engineering</i>
