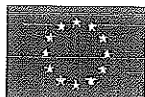

3. Learning programme

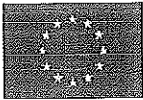
Activity 1: Participating in classes	
Description:	Spanish students will observe and participate in several classes of different subjects at the Polish institution.
Learning outcomes:	Spanish students will learn about the methodology used in a school from another country and be able to compare it with the methodology used in their own school. Key competences: - Cultural awareness and expression competence - Multilingual competence - Personal, social and learning to learn competence.



Activity 2: Local guides	
Description:	Polish students will guide Spanish students during shared visits and activities in their own country.
Learning outcomes:	Polish students will learn how to act as ambassadors of their own country. Key competences: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Cultural awareness and expression competence- Citizenship competence

Activity 3: Sustainability workshops and activities	
Description:	Students will participate in workshops and activities about sustainability inside and outside the school.
Learning outcomes:	Students will become more aware about the need to protect our people and our planet with our everyday decisions and they will take action with the design of some objects. Key competences: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Mathematical competence and competence in science, technology and engineering- Citizenship competence- Entrepreneurship competence

Activity 4: Cultural visits	
Description:	Students will visit different tourist attractions during the stay in Poland.
Learning outcomes:	Students will learn about local history and culture, and empower their European sense of belonging from a common past. Students will learn how to appreciate their architectural and artistic works, as well as, Polish habits and traditions. Key competences: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Cultural awareness and expression competence.




