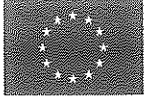

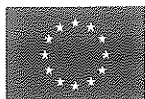

Portugal – stay in Stockholm, plane departs 19.30 from Arlanda

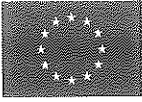
3. Learning agreement:

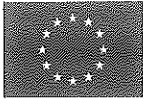
Activity 3: Cultural visits at Örebro	
Description	Students will visit different tourist attractions during the stay in Örebro: Old town (Wadköping), Örebro Castle.
Learning outcomes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Learn about local history and culture, and empower their European sense of belonging from a common past. - Learn how to appreciate their architectural and artistic works, as well as, habits and traditions.

Activity 4: Nature activities: from a dump to a natural research - an example of sustainable tourism	
Description	Students will visit to the Nature reserve OSET
Learning outcomes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Awareness of the importance of promoting environmental responsibility; - Discover an example of recovery of natural heritage; - Improve social skills and English language skills by working in group (teamwork and teambuilding);

Activity 5: Group research about sustainability at tourist sites (to prepare an exhibition)	
Description	In small groups the students will research different topics about sustainability in Örebro city (Hotels and shops, Nature, mobility-transport)
Learning outcomes	<p>Improve research skills to a responsible use of internet;</p> <p>Improve social skills by teamwork and teambuilding;</p> <p>Improve English language skills;</p> <p>Improve problem-solving and creative skills</p>

Activity 6: Local sustainable sport	
Description	Students will practice some sustainable sports such as ice skating.
Learning outcomes	<p>Improve social skills by cooperative learning (teambuilding)</p> <p>Improve new physical skills with the help of other students (balance, muscle control, coordination);</p> <p>Awareness of the importance of sports to promote health;</p> <p>Improve English language skills;</p>


