Bridging Europe through Expression, Respect & Speech

beTers is a two-year Erasmus+ school project involving 4 partner schools from different European countries (Finland, Portugal, Spain and Sweden). The main aim is to highlight and celebrate the beauty of Europe's cultural and natural diversity through the creation of a thematic digital Atlas of Diversity , which will culminate in a public exhibition in a local museum in May 2026 and in a public presentation of a printed book in May 2027.

OBJECTIVES:

- Foster appreciation of cultural, linguistic, and natural diversity in Europe.
- Encourage intercultural dialogue and mutual understanding among students and teachers.
- Develop a joint Atlas of Diversity that collects thematic maps and infographics (languages, cuisine, fauna and flora, dances, science history, demography, flags, anthems, etc.).
- Combine traditional research methods with digital tools to create interactive outputs.
- Improve students' ICT skills through the use of mapping tools, graphic design software, and online collaboration platforms.
- Promote safe and responsible use of digital resources.
- Train students in collecting, analysing, and representing data in creative and visual forms.
- Encourage curiosity and critical reflection about Europe's past, present, and future.
- Share project results with local communities through a public exhibition at a city museum.
- Strengthen the link between schools and their local cultural institutions.
